



HOW TO ACCESS LIBRARY RESOURCES?

Mr. Scott Meneely, father of Maria Meneely in CSL I class, works at the Carnegie Library. Recently, he gave a presentation to our students about what resources provided by the Carnegie Library. Here is Mr. Meneely's presentation:

Allegheny County residents: Everything is free – all you need is a library card! Bring a photo I.D. or proof of address, then you can apply for a library card. Once you have a library card, you can:

- use the card from any Allegheny county library to access these resources
- can have items shipped to the library most convenient to you

Pennsylvania residents from outside of Allegheny County: You can get an Allegheny County library card if you have a card from your local library that has the Access Pennsylvania logo like this:
